ELEPHANT LIFE.

Very little is known about the breeding of elephants as only a few have been bred in captivity. At Copenhagen one elephant has had three or four calves 'n many years. The period of gestation is about twentytwo months. They begin breeding at thirty years and continue until they are ninety years old.

Science has caught up to the humble

This fact is demonstrated in motion pictures taken under direction of Professor Jean Magnan of the College de France, which showed that the wings of the bumble bee beat 200 times a second. The camera used to accomplish this feet took 3,000 shots a sec-

In the film the bee could be seen moving its wings at a rate which apeared no faster than the legs of a man walking along the street. An ordinary motion picture camera is only capable of taking from sixteen to twenty-four shots a second while the human eye is even slower.

The bumble bee proved to be one of the fastest of insects. Films of other species clearly revealed that the wing movement of the butterfly are only from thirty to thirty-five beats a second as compared to the 110 of the common house fly.

THOROUGHBRED HORSES.

A thoroughbred horse is defined as having two qualifications: First, it must have an ancestry from noted stock, and, second, its pedigree must be recorded in the stud book for several generations-five for America and seven in England.

A whippet can run faster than a horse for a short distance, up to 100 yards, but for longer distances the horse is superior.

NOT A GREAT DIFFERENCE Although adult animals in the class of mammals vary in size from a mouse to a whale, a difference over 25,-000,000 times in bodily bulk, says Dr. E. E. Free, the eggs of these two extremes of the mammalian series differ by less than twice in diameter and only about eight times in bu'k. Mouse eggs are the smallest mammalian eggs, he says, just as mice are the smallest mammals. But there's not such a whale of a difference in the size of mouse eggs and whale eggs. Dr. C. G. Hartman of the Carnegie Institution of Washington has measured the egg cells from which both the young mouse and whale develop. The whale egg cell he found to be about 140 microns in diameter-about 1-200th of an inch. The mouse egg was found to be 75 microns in diameter, or more than half the size of the whale egg. Dr. Hartman also found the human egg cell to average about the size of the whale egg. 


