The Mud Wallow

Clean up the old yards and pens, with their mud holes, as such provide a place for the incubation of Round Worm eggs and other pests. Young pigs that are permitted to run in old yards and pens, that are usually heavily infested with parasite eggs. do so at considerable risk of picking up worm infestation that will make them unthrifty and unprofitable. Brood sows that are clean and worm free will, if given sanitary conditions, be in a much better position to produce and raise a full number of healthy pigs than the sow that is neglected as to worms and sanitation. The difference frequently makes a loss out of what might have been profitable production, had the details been looked after. Protect the young pigs against worm infestation until they are four months old, if you desire them to grow up to bacon weight at a profit. The worm free pig can be marketed before it is six months old, while the wormy pig may be eight to twelve months old. There is no profit in pigs sold at bacon weight after they have passed seven months of age. The profits or what might have been profits hav been consumed by the worms, for which there is no market.

A Valuable Counterfeit

Counterfeit coins whose value in creases with the disclosure of the fraud perpetrated are not common in the banking world. Recently, however, such a case came to light in London. Among a parcel of coins bought as gold was a clever imitation of a sovereign of 1863. Acid tests revealed that the coin was gilded platinum. At the time it was struck off. in the reign of Queen Victoria, platinum was worth only about one-third as much as gold. Now it is worth much more.




