Holland Plans **Farm Dictator**

Vanishing Foreign Trade Brings Drastic Proposal

To Curtail Production The Hague.-A bill introduced in the Second Chamber of the States General purposes to give the Dutch Government dictatorial powers to reorganize the affairs of the farmers and fruit and flower growers of the country. The agricultural crisis in Holland has arisen chiefly as a result of the recently erected barriers against exports.

Land owners and their tenants, as well as the merchants and the government, are realizing that the export markets, chiefly in England and Germany, lost by rising tariff walls and onerous regulations, will not be recovered soon, and that consequently the production of vegetables and dairy ed 88 per cent, haemoglobin and tested. commodities must be curtailed.

Preliminary measures are being taken to reduce drastically the output of eggs and milk. The annual export of butter has fallen from 47,000,000 kilograms to 10,000,000 kilograms while the wholesale price has dropped. The surplus thus created is being cleared up by compelling margarine manufacturers to include a larger proportion of butter in their products than hitherto. This regulation came into force on April 3 and ordered that the proportion of butter in all margarine should be raised from 25 to 40 per

Cheese Output Curtailed.

In the cheese trade a similar regulation has been made. Beginning in April and continuing for at least three months all wholesale Dutch cheese makers must reduce their output by 30 per cent., the consequent loss of profit being wholly or partially met by state compensation. The marketgarden trades will receive a subsidy from the government only on condition that they considerably reduce the amount of the planting.

This last restriction will be applied in a most comprehensive manner to the cultivation of bulb plants, a trade which is suffering from the home cultivation in America and England. After the flowering period of the present spring, enormous quantities of crocus, narcissus, hyacinth and tulip bulbs, as well as many planting beds for these bulbs, will be done away with. This view, that the Dutch means

of production must be reduced, has brought about a modification in the policy of subsidy hitherto followed by the state. The government has worked out an "empowering act" under which the carrying out of these measures is backed by extraordinary authority. The Government, in the preamble to the bill, cites well substantiated statements that in the agricultural lands exhaustion and impoverishment are rapidly spreading, and that in particular the offset of vegetables, fruit, eggs, potatoes, butter and cheese is in a lamentable con-

Three-Fold Course Proposed.

To prevent a complete and collective collapse of the rural retail trade the government desires to proceed along a three-fold way; first, by subsidies to the trade from a not yet established central crisis fund; secondly, by restriction of cultivation, and, thirdly, by the fixing of standard prices. But now comes the most important point. The proposed new law gives to the government the authority in case of necessity to use force in putting into execution the proposed measures. There is to be no persuasion and no argument. The instruction of the authorized official is to be a command to which obedience must be as explicit as that of the soldier


