



#### Only Woman Deputy Police Head Resigns Position in New York

New York - Miss Henrietta Addition, the only woman ever to hold a deputy police commissionership New York, is now out as head of the crime prevention bureau of the police department, her resignation having been accepted by Mr. Lewis J. Valen. tine, commissioner.

Simultaneously, Mr. Valentine announced that the crime prevention bureau would be reorganized, but he declined to give any plans and specifications on what would be done, And likewise, he refused to say who would be named as Miss Additon's successor. For the time being, he indicated the work will be under Inspector Louis S. Costuma, chief of the bureau's uniformed forces.

Neither Miss Addition nor the Commissioner would say why Miss Additon had resigned. She was appointed to the directorship of the bureau and as sixth deputy police commissioner on October 11th, 1930, succeeding Miss Virginia Murray. At the time of taking up this position she had served for a long time as a social worker and was active in the affairs of the women's city club and the New York League of Women Voters,

Prof. Roy V. Peel, chairman of the City Fusion Party expressed regret that Miss Addition was allowed to resign and urged the Fiorello H La-Guardia Fusion Mayoralty to reappoint her, although she was a Tammany appointee.
