

At this season of the year shells are more likely to be brittle and the contents to be of poorer quality, due to hair cracks and so called "grass" or dark yolks, and careful candling is advisable if the best prices ar to be obtained. Candle and grade ac cording to the Canadian Standard Egg Grading Regulations and pack wholesale shipments in clean fillers and good cases.

For a special high-grade trade eggs may be packed in neat cartons with an attractive "sticker" or scal guaranteeing the contents.


