Fall Hazards

veals the fact that accidents due to falls constitute a heavy drain on com pensation funds. Some of the chief causes of the falls are listed below for your consideration, with the hope that these hazards will be eliminated insofar as possible in your

individual operations: 1. Tripping over objects on floors and stairs.

2. Greasc, oil and water on floors and stairs. 3. Stepping on material that will

shift under foot. 4. Floors irregular or in poor con-5. Worn or broken steps or stairs.

6. Inadequate or no handrails on stairs and platforms. 7. Stairs with irregular tread. Loose or obstructed floors on scaffolds and platforms.
