

Ginger Bread

2 cups sifted cake flour, 2 teaspoons baking powder, 1/4 teaspoon soda, teaspoons ginger, 1 teaspoon cinnamon, 1/2 teaspoon salt 1-3 cup butter cup sour milk or buttermilk.

Sift flour once, add baking powder, soda, spices, and salt, and sift together three times. Cream butter thoroughly, add sugar gradually, and cream together until light and fluffy. Add egg and beat well; then molasses. Add flour, alternately with milk, a small amount at a time, beating after each addition until smooth Bake in greased pan, 8 x 8 x 2 inches. in moderate oven (350' F.) 50 minutes. Serve plain or with whipped cream flavored molasses.

Party Devil's Food Cake 2 cups sifted cake flour, 2% teaspoons baking powder, 1/4 teaspoon salt, 11/2 cups sugar, 3 eggs, well beaten, 3 squares unsweetened chocolate, melted, % cup milk, 1 teaspoon

United Church Council Hears Result of Presbytery Voting

OTTAWA-Reports of a commission on theological colleges and of a remit on the ordination of women were received recently by the General Council of the United Church of Canada.

Opening of the ministry to women on terms of equality with men has been agitated for years. Two years ago the General Council adopted the principle and remitted the question to all the presbyteries of the United Church for co-ordinate decision on enabling legislation.

Since the last General Council the voting has taken place in the presbyteries on the following remit: "That the ministry shall be open to both men and women." It was disclosed today that 80 presbytcries voted in favor of this legislation and 26 presbyteries were opposed. No result was available from eight presby-

A Remarkable Cat

End of Leap Year
