# GARDENING

**LAWNS**  
For best results grass seed must be sown in the cool weather. This means, according to the experts, that all the lawns or repair work must be made well before the first of June. At this time there is usually plenty of moisture and nights are cool. Success lies in the selection of the highest type of seed. There are all kinds of qualities offered, but the best blends for permanent results prove least expensive. In Canada there are laws governing grass seed but these have been designed only to protect the inexperienced from getting a lot of weed seeds instead of grass.  
With new lawns, the spade work should be done as early as possible. The main thing is to get the ground level. After digging or plowing, the ground should be allowed to settle for a few days at least, and then levelled again. If there is time, it is advisable to repeat this process several times. The top soil should then be raked fine and on a windless day the grass sown at a liberal rate, once across and then once lengthwise. This double sowing insures an even distribution. In covering, the gardener is advised to rake one way only and then firm the soil with a heavy roller or pounder. The first cutting of the grass is made when about three inches high and it should be done with a very sharp mower. Frequent mowings and, in general, the ground is soft, regular mowings, and an annual application of good lawn fertilizer is advisable.

There is something to build the rest of the garden around and there is less likely to be long blank periods when there is no bloom available. About a dozen different kinds will make a fair foundation. Here is a fair selection: Delphinium Hardy Chrysanthemum Phlox Hollyhocks Oriental Poppies Lillies Dianthus Trollius Peonias Yucca Columbine  
**SEED CATALOGUES**  
Seed catalogues put out by the large firms contain much more than a mere mention of the many flowers and vegetables available in Canada. They specify important points such as time of planting, resistance or lack of resistance to frost, height, color, season of blooming, whether scented, and also the suitability of the flower for cutting purposes. All of these points should be taken into consideration in planning a real garden, as only with such knowledge can a comprehensive and practical scheme be worked out.

## New Vegetables For Canadians

### To Be Grown In Their Gardens—Improvements In All Kinds Of Seeds Offered By Reputable Dealers.

New grains and fruits are not the only thing that have been occupying the attention of plant breeders in recent years. In vegetables there have been even more improvements. Scientists have carried out this work in two directions: first by the introduction of vegetables unfamiliar to most Canadians, and secondly and probably more important by vast improvement of those varieties that have been grown in this country for years.  
**Improved Varieties**  
Of the vegetables new to most Canadians there are several worth a trial in any garden. One is cos lettuce, a new cone shaped headed sort that stays fresh and sweet long after the leaf sorts have shrivelled up. Then there are Bussels sprouts, broad beans, broccoli, sugar peas, Chinese cabbage, chives, endive, egg plant, leek and Swiss chard. Full descriptions will be found in any Canadian seed catalogue.

## Canaries Detect Presence Of Gas

### In Coal Mines—Safety First Class Urged By Engineer

Two canaries kept by Bill Cunliffe, safety first engineer of Nova Scotia Steel and Coal Company's mines on the north side of Sydney harbor, play an important part in the protection of life underground.  
The two birds are taken into the collieries by the Captain of the Draegerman crew, and if there is gas present in the sections of the mine visited, they become unconscious.  
Cunliffe has been safety first engineer in Princess and Florence mines for more than 33 years now, and the steady decrease in the number of fatal and minor accidents in the two collieries over this period stands as a tribute to the excellent work he has carried out.  
**Should Learn First Principles**  
Built almost from nothing are two well-equipped first aid stations, an auxiliary motor ambulance. Cunliffe has interested more than 200 employees of Princess colliery in classes where the principles of safety first are taught. About 100 miners from Florence attend a similar class.  
"School children today are taught French, Latin, algebra, geometry, physics and other matters," says Cunliffe. "Yet they are not given an opportunity to learn the first principles of safety-first work—a work which sooner or later practically every person in Nova Scotia will have to face sometime in the near future."

## Grass Sown In Form Of Sheet

### Is New Invention For Lawns This Spring

Grass lawns can now be sown in the form of sheets of paper, like papering a wall, as a result of an invention of Mr. V. Hartley, a Fellow of the Royal Horticultural Society, says a story from London, Eng., in the Christian Science Monitor. The seed is supplied in 13 different mixtures suitable for the various soils in which it is intended to sow, and is incorporated in sheets of soft white paper, which easily decomposes. Held up to the light, the seeds can be seen in rows about three-eighths of an inch apart.  
**Measure Three Feet By Two**  
The ground to be sown is levelled and the surface covered with fine soil; the seed sheets measuring three feet by two feet are spread over it and kept moist, and under warm conditions the seed will germinate in from seven to ten days.
