ment, Scientist Discovers. Discovery that many wild animals suffer from chronic arthritis, one of the commonest and most painful diseases of man, has been announced as a probably new clue to methods of

conquering it. Speaking before the American Philosophical Society, one of the oldest scientific organizations in the United States, Dr. Herbert Fox of the University of Pennsylvania declared he had found the disease in a large varlety of animals, both in zoos and in

their natural habitat. In Zoos and Jungle It is frequently found in gorillas, baboons and other great apes related to man, he declared, but also is found in other animals, such as hyenas. It is even possible that some of the ancient dinosaurs had terrific cases of arthritis in the joints of their huge

The disease in animals appears to be chiefly an affliction of the spinal Display Here of walking or running may be the primary cause. New Approach to Problem Because of the similarity of the disease in animals and man a new approach to the study of arthritis, which has been a particularly puzzling medical problem for centuries, is opened up, said scientists who heard the re port. By producing it experimentally in animals the causes of it may be found and methods of prevention, or at least alleviation of it, may be worked out, they added.
