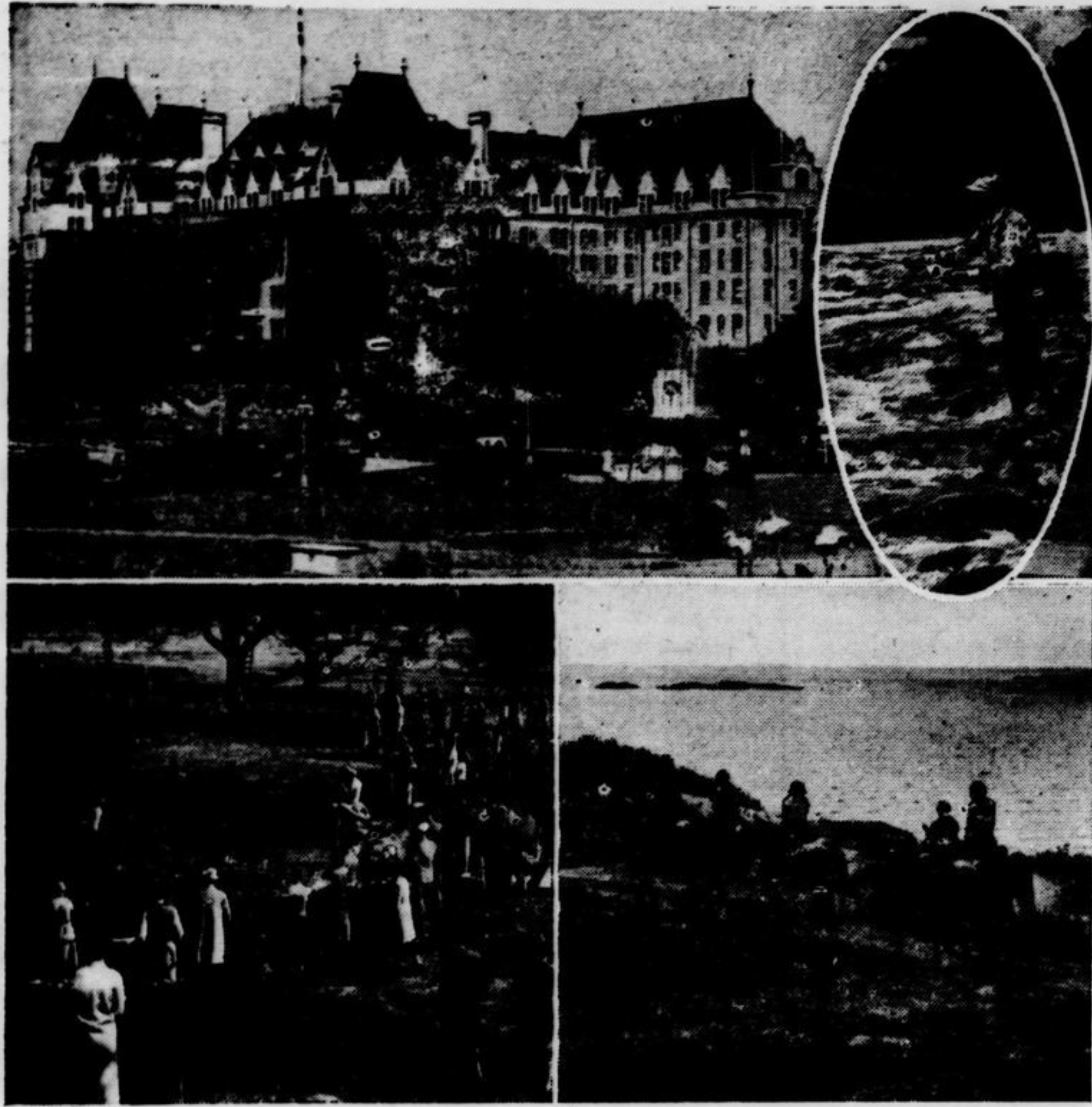


Victoria, Canada's Evergreen Playground

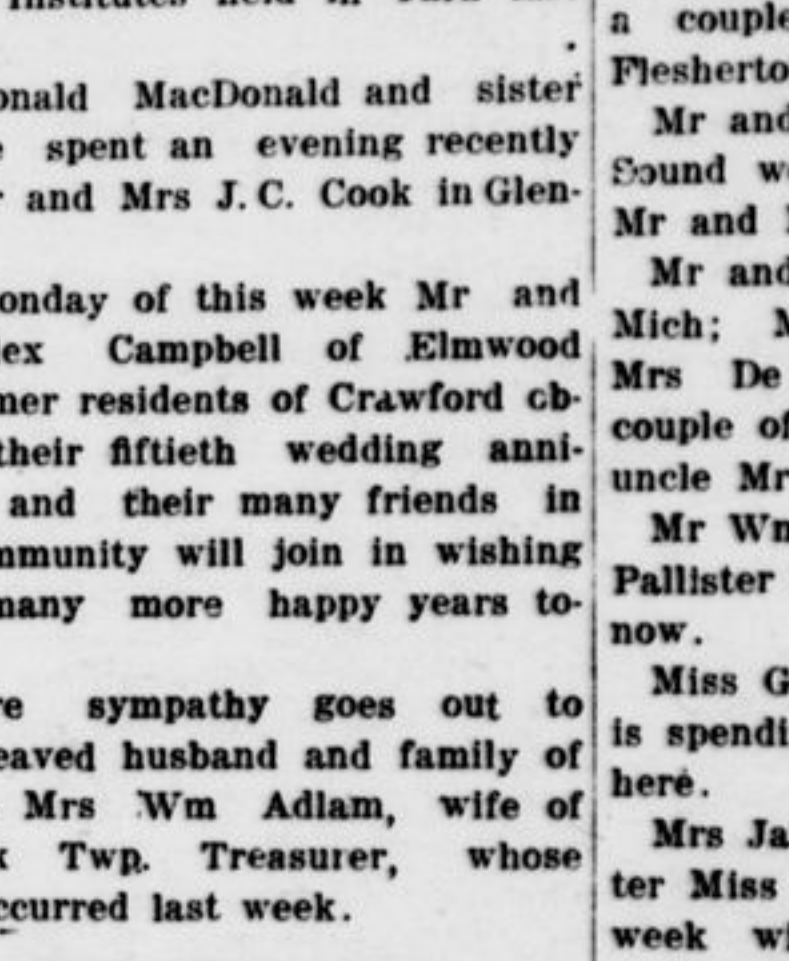
