### Blames Men For Killings By Owls

Naturalist Places Large Share of Responsibility on Humans for Taking Away the Owls' Food

Those who are aroused to anger by the "murder" of small birds by owls should not place all the blame on the larger birds alone; for man himself must bear a large share of the responsibility. At least, that is the contention of Angus Buchanan, president of the Essex Nature Club, speaking on birds and their habits, at Windsor last week.

NATURE'S SYSTEM UPSET Mr. Buchanan pointed out that owls are specially fitted for feeding on field mice, rabbits and other small animals. Nature has provided them with soft feathers, so they may swoop down on the keen-eared field mice without being heard. Farmers, however, make an annual practice of wip-

ing out these little creatures, and the owl is forced to place robins and bluebirds on his menu. SOME TRAVEL AT NIGHT

Certain birds, Mr. Buchanan said, migrate by night and feed during the day. This is a protection instinct against predatory birds and the nests of these birds will be found in the most remote thickets. Others, robins and bluebirds, fight their way from one place to another, flying by

### **Eels Supply** Rich Vitamin

Quebec Industrialist Reveals New Use for Fish

Discovery of an eel liver oil that when distilled is said to contain more Vitamin A than cod liver oil, was announced last weekk by its discoverer, Lucien Faguy, Quebec industrialist.

Faguy said that according to experiments the oil, once distilled, was shown to contain 1,100 units of Vitamin A compared with 1,000 in distilled cod liver oil.

The experiments, Faguy said, are being carried out by Dr. Joseph Risi, titular professor of organic chemistry at Laval University there under the auspices of the provincial Department of Commerce and Industry.

Number of vitamins in the refined oil is not yet known. Faguy said, but results of further experiments are expected within a few weeks.

## What Science Is Doing

459 BELOW ZERO

When scientists write about low-temperature research they are thinking of temperature about 450 dgrees below zero Fahrenheit, says the "Scientific American." The rock bottom of the thermometer, is only 459 degrees below the familiar Fahrenheit zero. Nothing has ever been taken quite to this bottom temperature, although scientists have come within a small fraction of 1 degree of it.

EPILEPSY HEREDITARY Definite proof that epilepsy is inherited has been obtained through the use of the electroencephalograph, or brain wave machine. Persons suffering from epilepsy have a charteristic slow brain wave of large amplitude with a peculiar egg-and-dart out-

Tests on 138 parents and children revealed that among the children of epilpetic parents 54 per cent were epleptic, while in a control group of unrelated children only 6 per cent showed this condition.

AID TO CANCER STUDY Dr. Henry J. Andrews, president of the Federation of Natural Sciences of Southern California, believes that co-operation between geological and medical science ultimately may culminate in the elimination of cancer.

Basis for his prediction, Dr. Andrews says, is the recent application of the spectograph and polarograph, metallurgical instruments used in rock analysis, in the study of cancer causes.
