AFRIMISHING EFFECTS OF A SOUTH AMERICAN TIDAL WAVE.—Washington, June 11.—The United States Minister in Chili, Mr. Osborn, sends to the Department of State an interesting despatch on the earthquake and tidal wave of May, 1877, founded on observations made during a personal visit to the scene of the disaster.
