Durham, May 18th, 1882.

The Dominion Parliament was prorogued yesterday. Many of the members had left previous to prorogation.

The postage on newspapers mailed from the office of publication in Canada will be abolished after the first of June next, by an Act passed at the present session of the Commons.

The people of Manitoba and the Northwest, who are groaning under the heavy burdens and restrictions caused by the infamous bargain of Sir John A. Macdonald and his obsequious followers with the Railway Syndicate have begun to realize that they have a remedy in their own hands, and the local Government under the leadership of Mr. Norquay will be defeated if it attempts to render to the dictates of the Dominion Government.
