The Austrian Cabinet is using its influence to bring about an understanding between England and Turkey.

Rome, Aug. 5.—The action of the British in occupying the Suez surprised everyone here.

Monday's despatches from Constantinople presented a more hopeful aspect of affairs at the Conference. At that day's sitting the Turkish representative announced the Porte's acceptance of the conditions of the indemnity note regarding Turkish intervention; and the formation of an international police for the protection of the Suez Canal. He also informed Lord Dufferin that in accordance with his demand Arabi would be proclaimed a rebel. This conciliatory action on the part of the Sultan was probably hastened by the announcement that Russian troops had been ordered to prepare to embark for Constantinople immediately on war breaking out between England and Turkey. Two Turkish Commissioners sail immediately for Alexandria and it is hoped that Arabi's troops will submit to Dervish Pasha on his arrival. At Alexandria matters remain very quiet pending Sir Garnet Wolseley's arrival. Her Majesty has personally made enquiries after the sick and wounded soldiers. Arabi brought up troops from Kaf-el-Dawn to repair and strengthen his entrencheds. He still appears to hope for success, and is keeping up communication with the Porte. One of his couriers has been intercepted and his dispatches taken from him.
