British Drink Statistics In the annual analysis of the statistics of the liquor traffic in Great Britain for 1894, prepared by Dr. Dawson Burns, it appears that the total retail cost of the liquor consumed in the United Kingdom in 1894 was £128,377,828, as compared with £128,364,929 in 1893. The expenditure in 1894 was thus less than in 1893 by £12,000.
