BELL'S NEW-FOUND RIVER.

EXPLORATION OF A NEGLECTED DRAINAGE SYSTEM. It is found to be of unexpected importance—a vast area in Quebec Falls is watered into a central channel which flows into Hudson Bay.

The actual survey extended completely across to James Bay, the south end of Hudson Bay, and up the east shore of James Bay to Rupert House, the position of which had been accurately determined.
