The rumor that King Menelek is negotiating with the dervishes for an alliance against the whites may be dismissed as groundless. There is cause for an alliance in their common hosility to the Italians, and the avowed surpose of England to assist Italy by means of the Nile expedition, which is thus directed against both Abyssinians and Madhists, But the former are nominally Christian and the latter fauatical Moslems; they are separated by race hatred more bitter than that which divides the Russian from the Turk, and by the tradition of generations of warfare which make one a hill fighter and the other warriors of the desert and the plain. Beside, the victory before Adowa, and the request of Italy through an envoy to state his terms of peace, must go far to convince Menelek that the conquest of his dominions is beyond the Italian power, and so to diminish the probability that he is seeking an alliance. Nevertheless, the fact that it has been deemed probable is insignificant of the change which is going on in the conditions of warfare between the white and the dark races, the latter rapidly learning upon what success depends, and as rapidly increasing their capacity for defence.
