THE GAME LAWS.

You'll For the information of the many who find time and inclination to go a hunting, we publish a portion of the laws relating to the subject.

It shall be unlawful for any person to catch, kill or destroy, or pursue with such intent, grouse, pheasants, prairie fowl or partridge, woodcock, snipe, rail, plover, or any other water fowl or other game-bird or animal (including black & grey squirrels, and hares) not herein otherwise provided for, at any time between the fifteenth day of December and It shall be unlawful for any person to tween the fifteenth day of December and the fifteenth day of September in the following year.

Or ducks of all kinds at any time between the fifteenth day of December and the first day of the following month of September.

Notwithstanding anything in this section contained, any one may at any time hunt, take or kill that species of hares commonly known in this Province as the cotton-tail rabbit, or any species of rab-

The possession of gun, decoys or other implements of shooting or hunting at a time and in places where the game birds or animals above named are usually found shall be prima facie evidence of pursuit thereof with intent to catch, kill or destroy the same.

No person shall kill or shoot at any bird or wild fowl protected by this act, between half an hour after sunset and half an hour before sunrise.

No eggs of any of the birds above mentioned shall be taken, destroyed or had in possession by any person at any

No person shall have in his possession any of the said hereinbefore mentioned animals or birds, no matter where procured, or any part or portion of any such animals or birds, during the periods in which they are so protected; provided that they may be exposed for sale for five days, and no longer, after such per-iods, and may be had in possession for the private use of the owner and his family at any time, but in all cases the proof of the time of killing, taking or purchasing shall be on the person so in

No person shall by himself, his servant, clerk or agent, expose or keep for sale or directly or indirectly, upon any pretence, or device, sell or barter, or in consideration of the purchase of any other property, give to any other person any snipe, woodcock or partridge, no matter where killed or procured, before the fifteenth day of September, 1897, or any quail or wild turkey before the fifteenth day of October, 1897."

It shall not be lawful for any person to kill or take any animal protected by this Offices :- Upstairs, CALDER BLOCK. Act by the use of poison, or poisonous substances, nor to expose poison, poison-ed bait or other poisoned substances in \$25,000 to loan at lowest rates o any place or locality where dogs or cat-tle may usually have access to the same.

None of the hereinbefore mentioned animals or birds shall be trapped or taken by means of traps, nets, snares, gins, ances; nor shall such traps, nets, snares, gins, baited lines or contrivances be set for them or any of them at any! time; and such traps, nets, snares, gins, baited lines or contrivances may be destroyed by any person Without such persons thereby incurring any liability therefor, if he shall find them so set.

Women Rule In New Zealand.

Woman continues to pursue her conquering way in New Zealand. All the ladies of that colony who have attained the age of 21 are legally qualified to vote at parliamentary elections. A lady, Miss Yates, is the duly elected mayor of an important borough. Another lady, Miss Lillian Edgar, has recently been elected a member of the governing body of the University of Auckland, and by the last mail we hear of the ladies securing three out of the seven seats on a school board. Furthermore, one of the three ladies has been chosen as president of the board for the ensuing year. -London Star.

Not So Easy to Entertain Royalty. Apparently the entertaining of royalty has its little disadvantages. When the Princess of Wales accepted Lady Dudley's invitation to her dance last week, she stipulated that only 150 people were to be asked. When the list of the chosen was sent to Marlborough House, so many were struck off that only 30 unmarried girls were left, several of the hostess' own near relatives being ruled out.
