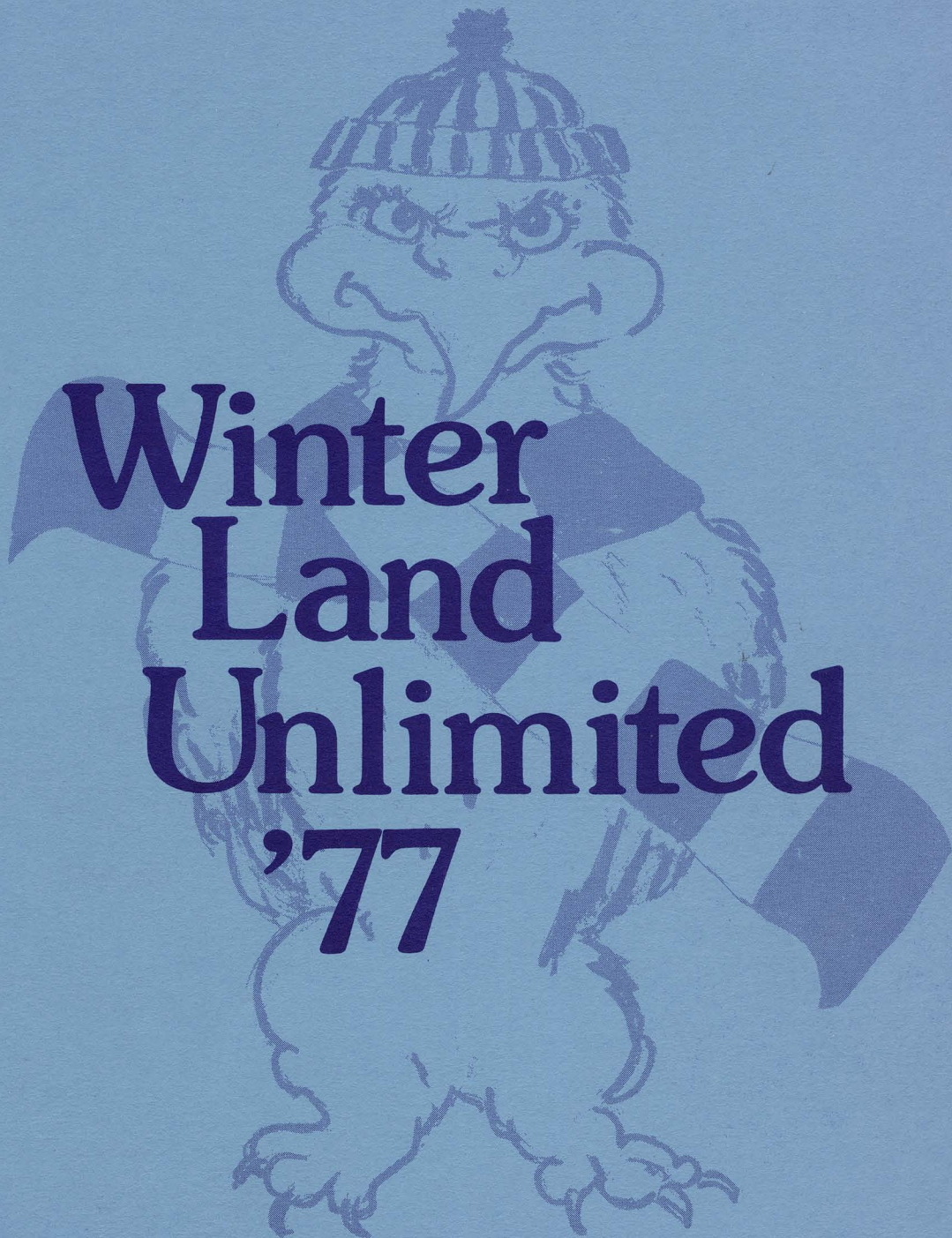

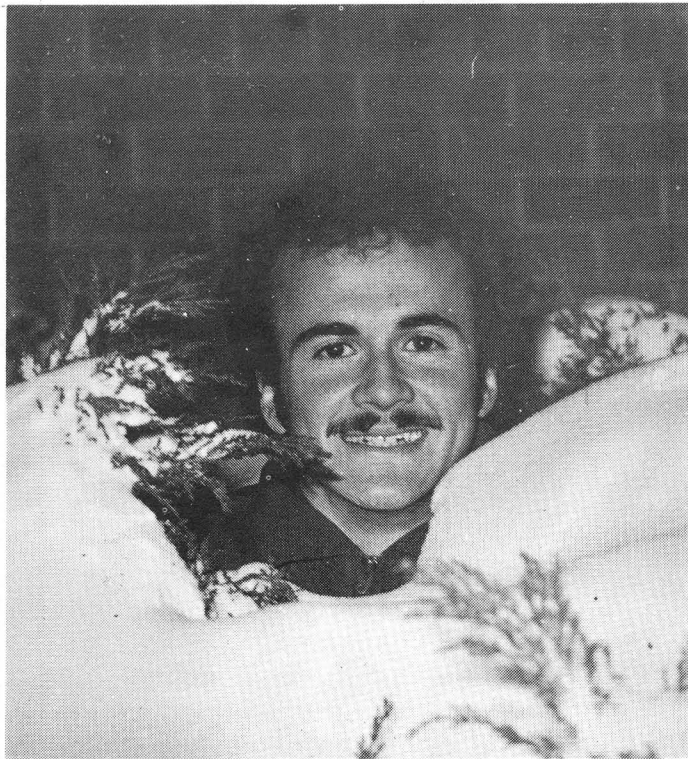

Molsons is sponsoring a billiards tournament in the games room from Monday until Friday. Prizes will be provided.

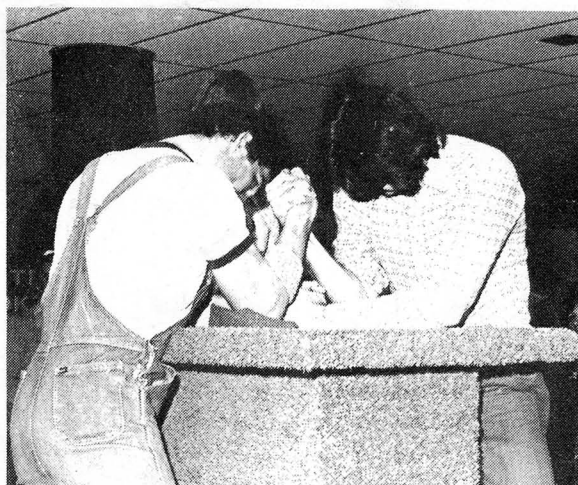


## PINBALL TOURNAMENT

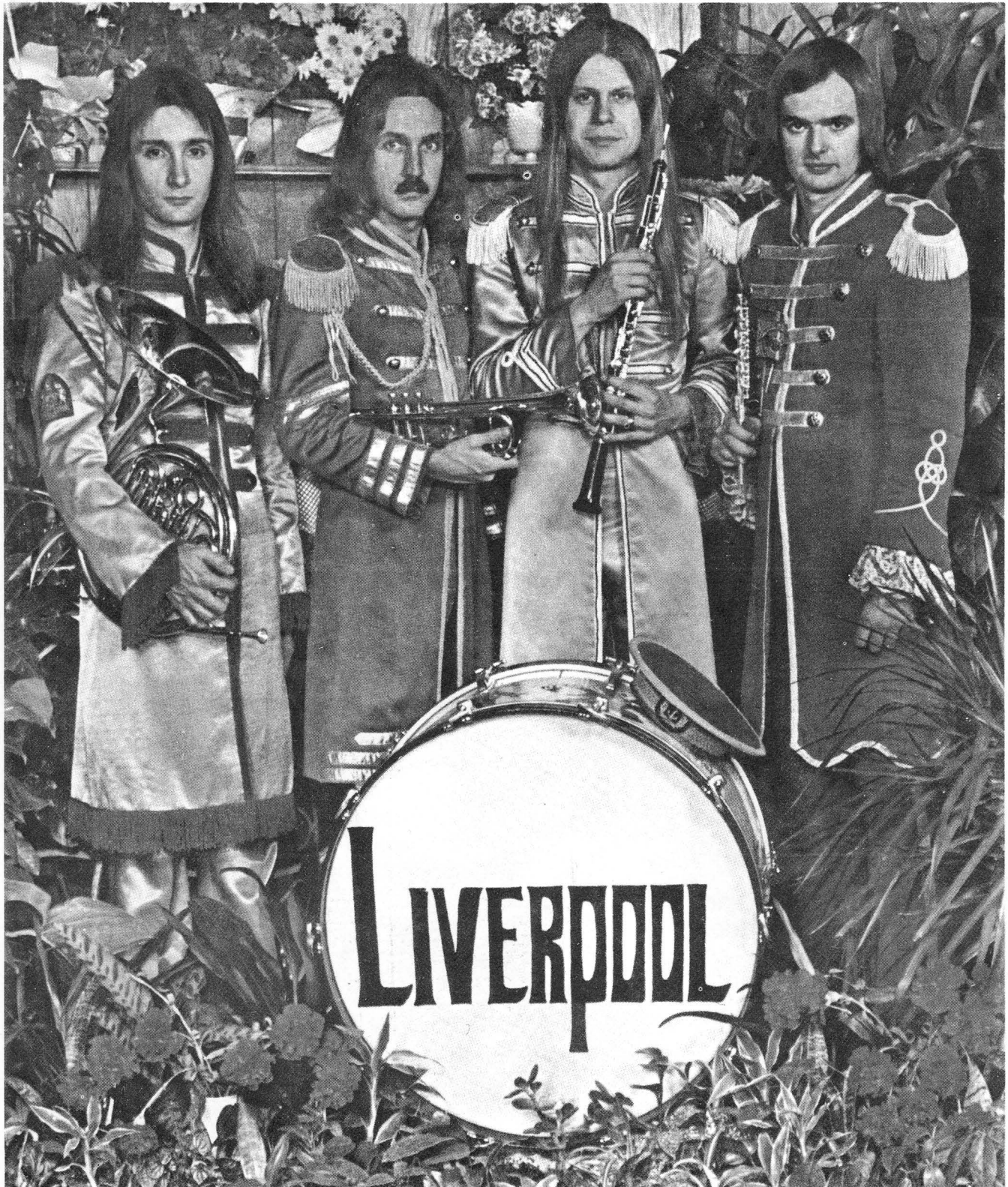
## SLEIGHRIDE!

## SKATING

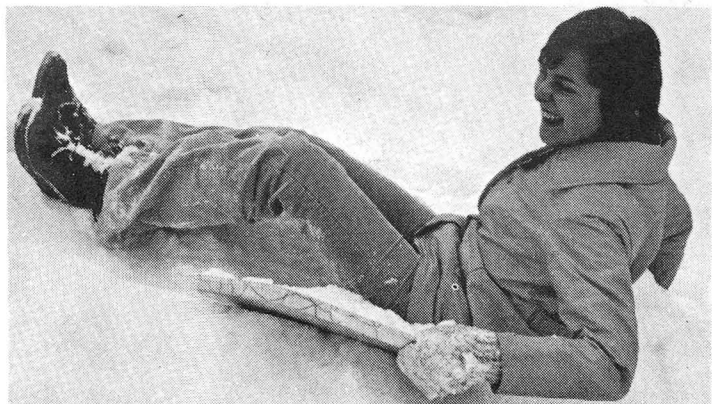
Wednesday & Thursday

**No prior experience necessary.** Running shoes or other proper footwear will be required. Brooms are limited, so bring your own, if possible.

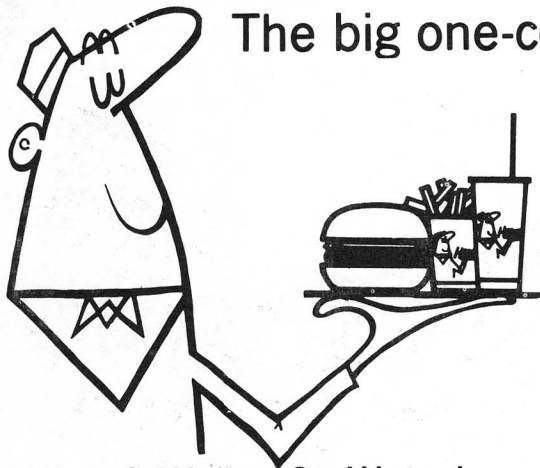

The second ski trip to Blue Mountain leaves at 6:50 a.m. from in front of the T.A. Again the cost is only \$9.00 and buses are provided.

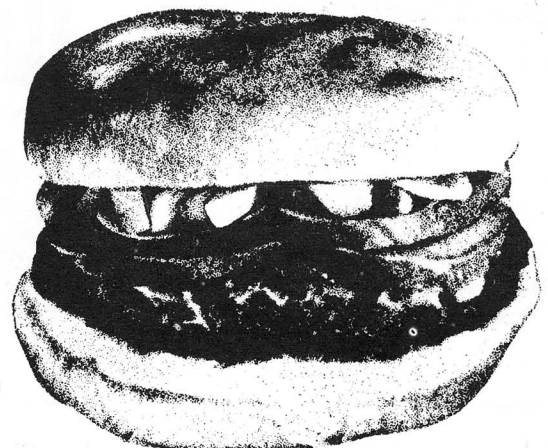
## CASINO PUB NIGHT

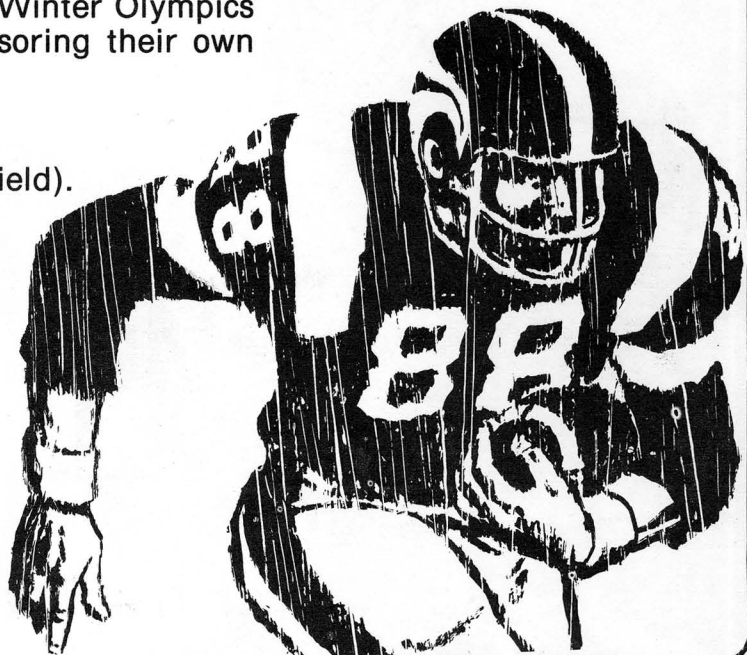

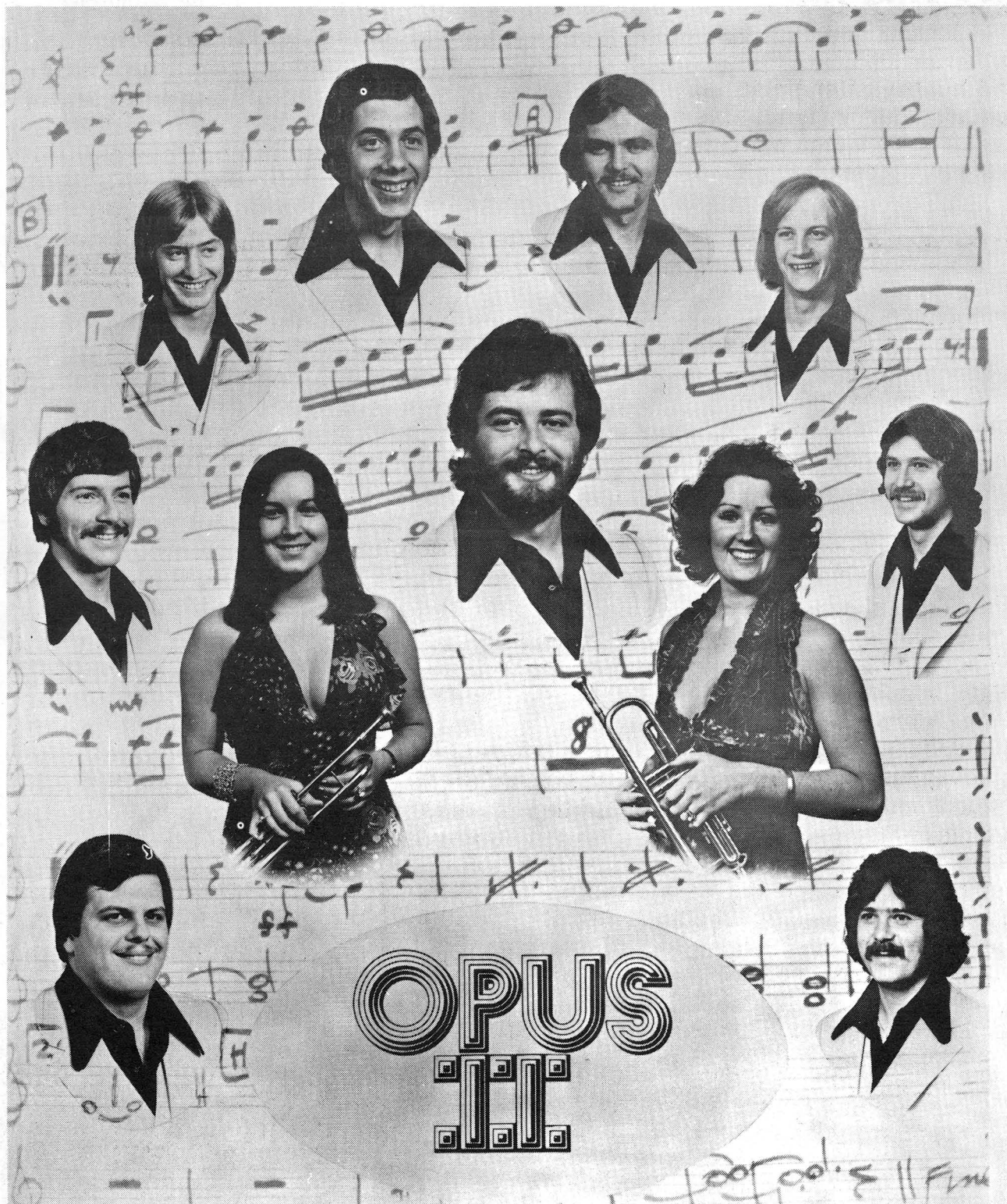
For those of you who can't make it to the Winter Olympics at Lake Placid, New York, WLU is sponsoring their own Mini Olympics.

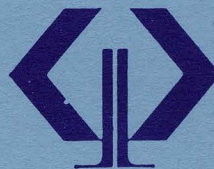
