To Accept Degrees from WLU on May 25

Paul Martin, Canada's high commissioner to Great Britain, flies home to Canada in May to preside over the spring convocation of Wilfrid Laurier University. Mr. Martin is the university's chancellor.

He will be host at the chancellor's luncheon on the university campus May 25 and then will confer honorary degrees upon two distinguished Canadians at the convocation ceremony at the Kitchener Auditorium.

Receiving honorary degrees will be John Evans, president of the University of Toronto; and Reuben Baetz of Ottawa, executive director of the Canadian Council on Social Development.

More than 700 students from the university's full-time and many part-time programs will receive degrees at the same time in arts, science, business and economics, music, social work and theology.
