500 Students to Explore Their Future  
at WLU Day on November 5

Five hundred senior high schools, teachers and guidance counsellors from across the province will be on campus at Wilfrid Laurier University Nov. 5 for WLU Day. Theme for the day is Exploring Your Future.

Student visitors will be welcomed by Dr. Frank C. Peters, the university's president, and then will have an opportunity to sit in on any university lecture or seminar group that interests them.

There will be a campus tour, conducted by WLU students, and special displays by the biology, history, English and geography departments, and demonstrations by the departments of chemistry, physics and psychology.

Visitors will also hear about the new co-operative option in business administration, an option that allows students to combine academic studies with practical work experience. The co-op option is the only one in the province at the undergraduate level.

In addition, the music faculty will present a woodwind quintet concert by members of the Stratford Festival Ensemble. Members of the ensemble are faculty members at the university.
