Bach's Mass in B Minor to be Presented
by Laurier Singers and K-W Symphony

The Laurier Singers of Wilfrid Laurier University will be joined by the Kitchener-Waterloo Symphony Orchestra for a presentation of J. S. Bach's Mass in B Minor April 13 in Waterloo and April 14 in Hamilton. Conductor will be Victor Martens of the WLU faculty of music.

Soloists for the performances will be Deloris Dueck and Lynda Neufeld, sopranos; Lillian Kilianski, alto; John Martens, tenor; Ted Baerg, baritone; and Ken Baker, bass.
