200 High School Coaches Expected for 8th

Annual WLU Football Clinic, May 14-15

More than 100 football coaches from high schools throughout Ontario have already registered and 200 are expected for the eighth annual football clinic at Wilfrid Laurier University, May 14-15.

Guest lecturers are John Mummey, Ohio State University; Ron Bell, Cameron Heights Collegiate, Kitchener; Frank (Blackie) Johnston, formerly of the Toronto Argos and now with the Lakeshore Bears; Fred Dunbar, University of Guelph; Garney Henley, Hamilton Tiger Cats; and Rich Newbrough, coach and associate athletic director at WLU.

Topics to be covered include Options from the "I" Formation, Offensive Principles, Offensive Blocking Techniques, Treatment of Athletic Injuries, and a discussion of the Cameron Heights Defense.

A feature will be the coaches corner, where those attending can huddle with the lecturers to get answers to specific questions. There also will be displays by suppliers and manufacturers.

The event gets under way with registration in the WLU athletic building at 6:30 p.m. May 14. Two lectures will be given that night and four more the next day.
