Shakespearean Film Series is

The showing of 10 film adaptations of Shakespearean plays will be jointly sponsored by the English department of Wilfrid Laurier University and the Kitchener Public Library. The free showings, open to the public, will begin Sept. 23 at 7 p.m.

The first film, *Richard III*, a 1955 film directed by and starring Sir Lawrence Olivier, will be shown in room 1E1 of the arts building at WLU on University Avenue, Waterloo.

The second movie, *Macbeth*, will be shown at the Kitchener Public Library on Oct. 18. The film was directed by Roman Polanski in 1971.

The following films will also be shown: *Falstaff*, Nov. 11, WLU; *Henry V*, Nov. 25, WLU; *The Taming of the Shrew*, Dec. 6, Library; *As You Like It*, Jan. 20, WLU; *King Lear*, Jan. 31, Library; *Hamlet*, Feb. 24, WLU; *Romeo and Juliet*, March 7, Library; and *A Midsummer Night's Dream*, March 17, WLU.

The four films at the Kitchener Public Library will be shown in the Library Auditorium on Queen Street North.
