COVERAGE IS INVITED

John M. Ramsay to receive  
honorary WLU degree Nov. 7.

A special fall convocation in Barrie for graduates of the university's Simcoe campus takes place Sunday at 3 p.m. in the Barrie Central Collegiate auditorium.

An honorary doctor of laws degree will be conferred upon J. M. (Jack) Ramsay, director of education for the Simcoe County Board of Education. In addition, 42 students who have completed work for degrees will receive them at the convocation.

Mr. Ramsay has held a number of important posts in education, served the ministry on a committee investigating education costs, and is the author of a textbook on physics. He is a past-president of the Ontario Association of Education Officials, and presently is a director of the Canadian Education Association.

Following the ceremony, to which the public is invited, there will be a reception for the graduates, their families and friends at the school, jointly sponsored by the university and the Simcoe county education committee of the Ontario Public School Men Teachers' Federation.

The university has been offering part-time degree courses in the county for more than 12 years, first in Orillia and now at Base Borden and Barrie as well.
