About 400 Year 4 and 5 (Grade 12 and 13) students from throughout Ontario will be at Wilfrid Laurier University March 3 for a day of varied activities called WLU Day.

The students, and their guidance counsellors, teachers and principals, will be greeted by Dr. Frank C. Peters, WLU president. Afterward, they will be free to attend any lecture that interests them.

In addition, there will be presentations by many departments with displays, films and tours. There will be an opportunity, too, for students to chat about entrance requirements, programs and financial aid.

Arthur Stephen, director of liaison, said the day--the second WLU Day for this academic year--should provide an opportunity for students to decide whether WLU is the place for them when they complete high school.
