WLU faculty of music will host the
CAUSM and CAML conference June 1-3

Wilfrid Laurier University's faculty of music will host two member organizations of the Learned Societies of Canada this summer.

The Canadian Association of University Schools of Music (CAUSM) and the Canadian Association of Music Libraries (CAML) will meet together at WLU to attend a three day conference from June 1 to 3. About 120 delegates from CAUSM and 30 from CAML are expected.

In addition to the regular sessions of papers and round-table discussions the faculty of music has arranged a series of short recitals for the delegates. Recitalists are Barrie Cabena (organ), Sonya Monosoff (baroque violin), Peggie Sampson (viola da gamba) and Garth Beckett and Boyd McDonald (piano duo) and the Stratford Ensemble.

Delegates will also have the opportunity to attend two operas-- Puccini's Gianni Schicchi and Monteverdi's Il Combattimento di Tancredi e Clorinda. The operas are presented by the WLU Opera Workshop in conjunction with the UW Arts Centre and the K-W Symphony.

The public is also invited to attend the operas on June 2 and 3 at the Humanities Theatre at UW. The performances begin at 8 p.m. Tickets are \$4 for adults and \$2.50 for students and seniors.
