William H. Timmis re-elected
chairman of WLU board of governors

William H. Timmis of Waterloo, a prominent business executive was returned as chairman of the board of governors of Wilfrid Laurier University at the board's annual meeting. He has been chairman since 1975.

Mr. Timmis is president of Milling Products Ltd. of Chatham, a director and first vice-president of the Equitable Life Insurance Company of Waterloo, and a director of the Waterloo Mutual Insurance Company.
