WLU student pub raises

\$755 for Terry Fox fund

A recent evening at Wilfrid Laurier University's student pub was designated Terry Fox night. All those attending were invited to make a donation to the fund named for the Canadian who ran a Marathon of Hope before being stricken once again by cancer.

The WLU Student Union turned a cheque for \$619 over to Randy Stewart representing the Canadian Cancer Society. A further \$136.50 was raised in the hour following, bringing the total donation to \$755.50.

Earlier in the year, freshmen students at Laurier held Shinerama, when they shined shoes throughout the two cities, and raised \$4,600 for cystic fibrosis research.

Shinerama was initiated by WLU more than 15 years ago.
