Enrolment up across board
at Wilfrid Laurier University

Enrolment at Wilfrid Laurier University this fall is showing an increase in all areas, Dr. Neale H. Taylor, WLU president, told the board of governors of Laurier last week.

He said arts and science enrolment, as of his report, stood at 1,827 compared with 1,761 a year ago.

Other areas with enrolment now as compared with the final figure a year ago are school of business and economics 1,665 (1,598 last year), and music 169 (165).

In addition, WLU Telecollege, which operates a growing number of courses through TVOntario, has an enrolment of 156 to date and more being processed, compared with 55 last year.

We expect by November 1, when we make our first official tally, we will have between 3,500 and 3,600 full-time undergraduate students, compared with 3,464 last year.
