Two Toronto business executives
head Wilfrid Laurier University fund

J.C. Phillips, chairman of the board of Gulf Canada Ltd., Toronto, is the national chairman of Wilfrid Laurier University's national development fund aimed at raising \$6.2 million over five years.

Announcement of the appointment of Mr. Phillips was made by Dr. Neale H. Tayler, president of Laurier, at the recent meeting of the university's board of governors.

Dr. Tayler also told the board that J.A. Gordon Bell, president and chief operating officer of the Bank of Nova Scotia, will serve as honorary treasurer.

"They will lead a distinguished group of public-spirited men and women from across Canada who have volunteered their services to ensure that we reach our objective in a six-month campaign," Dr. Tayler said.

The campaign will raise funds for a two-floor addition to the library building, bringing it to its planned height, and complete the first stage of a new building for the music faculty.

Other projects include increasing computer facilities, renovation of science laboratories, upgrading of food service equipment, additional athletic and recreational equipment and other projects.
