2 successful Elmira high school graduates

meet at Wilfrid Laurier University awards luncheon

John E. Brent, the retired chairman of the board of I.B.M. Canada Ltd., and a graduate of Elmira District High School some years ago, met a more recent Elmira graduate at an awards luncheon in Waterloo.

Mr. Brent was presenting three \$1,000 scholarships to students in Wilfrid Laurier University's school of business and economics. One of the winners--all are known as Brent scholars--was James W. Moore of West Montrose; a third-year student in honors economics and political science.

Like the man handing out the scholarships, James Moore also attended the Elmira high school.

Others receiving Brent scholarships were D. Mark Warren of Brechin, first year honors business; and William Heffner of Kitchener, second-year honors business student.

Mr. Brent, who graduated from Laurier and the University of Western Ontario, and received honorary doctorates from both, awards the scholarships annually to the highest ranking student at the end of the first, second and third year of the four-years honors programs in the Laurier school of business and economics.
