Special anniversaries to be marked  
as Laurier holds Homecoming '82

The 25th anniversary of the Class of '57 will be a major highlight when Wilfrid Laurier University stages Homecoming '82 all-day Sept. 25.

Other special gatherings will include a reunion marking the 20th anniversary of the university's biology department, the 20th anniversary of the Class of '62 and the 10th reunion for graduates of the school of business and economics.

And sports will be highlighted, too, with a 10th reunion for all Golden Hawks trophy winners. The Golden Hawks is the team name for every sport played on campus.

Marjorie Millar, director of development and alumni affairs, said the day will begin with a champagne brunch in the Paul Martin Centre on campus at 10 a.m. A business meeting and election of officers follows.

The homecoming parade leaves campus at 12:30 p.m., led by Dr. John A. Weir, president of WLU and Randy McGlynn, president of the alumni association in a 1931 Ruxton roadster, often used as a symbol for Laurier. The parade will end at Seagram Stadium in time for the 2 p.m. football game between Laurier and the University of Western Ontario Mustangs.

There will be a variety of social events, following, including a special smorgasbord dinner for all biology alumni.

A dance in the large Turret ballroom of the student building brings the day to a close.
