WLU economist to give seminar  
to women members at Westmount

Prof. Ralph Blackmore, associate professor of economics at Wilfrid Laurier University's school of business and economics, will offer a series of six weekly one and a half hour lectures on managing your investments to women members of Westmount Golf and Country Club beginning Oct. 19.

The series was arranged by women members of the Kitchener club. About 30 members have signed up to date.

Prof. Blackmore, well-known for his weekly commentary program on CKCO-TV news, is the former financial editor of the Globe and Mail in Toronto.

On Nov. 14, Prof. Blackmore will give a seminar for members of the Zonta Club, a women's business and professional association, at the Holiday Inn, Guelph on portfolio management.
