Gallery owner presents paintings

by Guilhauman to music faculty

Marian Pillach, owner of Gallery 12 in Waterloo, will present two framed oil paintings by Horst Guilhauman to the music faculty of Wilfrid Laurier University Feb. 1 at 7 p.m.

He will make the presentation on campus where a display of works by Guilhauman are on display in the Concourse Gallery. The show, open during regular university hours, closes Feb. 11.

Prof. Michael Purves-Smith, a member of the music faculty, said one of the paintings will be displayed in the lobby area of the music building. No decision has been made about the second.

The painting to be displayed in the music building (Macdonald Hall) shows a musician playing on a faculty grand piano. Model for the musician was Lorraine Flatt, a part-time instructor in the faculty.

The second painting shows a pumpkin farm near Peterborough, Ont.
