Seminars, Parade, Reunions

Homecoming '83 at Wilfrid Laurier University will begin on September 22 when returning graduates join in a sing along in the campus pub and will end three days later with a Sunday brunch around the pool at the Waterloo Inn.

In between there will be a variety of events, including Alumni College, new this year. It will feature a session on executive development and another on the Japanese industrial system.

Graduates of the Class of '33 will celebrate their 50th anniversary at a dinner on Friday night, with members of the Founders Chapter (1911-1936) as special guests. The Class of '58 will mark its 25th anniversary at a cocktail reception that evening.

On Saturday there will be a mile-long parade with sponsored floats and marching bands. It will leave the campus at 12:15 p.m. and wind through uptown Waterloo before returning to the campus for the judging of the floats.

The Saturday afternoon football game between the Laurier Golden Hawks and the Toronto Varsity Blues is expected to bring a good turn-out of alumni for the 2:00 p.m. kick off.

A number of special group get-togethers and the annual Homecoming dance at 8:00 p.m. in the Turret lounge on campus will round out the day.
