Tuition fees rise by 5 per cent  
at Wilfrid Laurier University

Tuition fees for students entering Wilfrid Laurier University this fall will increase by five per cent, bringing them to \$1,130 from this year's \$1,076.

Part-time tuition will rise by the same amount, bringing each course registration to \$227 from \$216. At Simcoe County centres the fees go to \$231 per course, from \$220.

Residence fees will rise by 7.6 per cent and dining hall meal cards by 6.6 per cent. This brings a shared room in residence for the year to \$1,415 from \$1,315, and a five-day meal card to \$1,445 from \$1,355.

The higher fees charged visa students brings their fees to \$2,249 for those registered prior to Sept. 1, 1982 and to \$4,047 for those registered after that date. These also are 5 per cent increases.
