WLU teleconferencing added  
in Midland and Collingwood

Residents of Midland and Collingwood, in addition to Barrie residents, will now be able to complete university credit courses this fall in their own communities.

Wilfrid Laurier University will add teleconferencing courses in sociology with classes meeting weekly, beginning Sept. 13, in Huronia District Hospital in Midland, and the General and Marine Hospital in Collingwood.

In teleconferencing, a professor teaches in one centre and his voice is heard in classrooms where students gather in other centres. Anyone wishing to take part in discussions uses a desk microphone and the professor and students at all centres can participate.

Introduction to Sociological Study will be offered this fall and Introduction to Data Collection Methods in Sociology in the spring.
