Papal visit suggests social justice
as topic for lecture at WLU Sept. 27

The papal visit to Canada this year suggested the topic, Social Justice and the Economic Order, for the 11th annual Easton-McCarney memorial lecture at Wilfrid Laurier University Sept. 27 at 8 p.m.

The speaker will be Dr. Tony Clarke of Ottawa, co-director of the social affairs department, Canadian Conference of Catholic Bishops. The free, public lecture will be given in the main auditorium of the Frank C. Peters Building, Albert St. and University Ave., Waterloo.

Dr. Clarke assisted in preparing the recent statements and documents from the Canadian Conference of Catholic Bishops on ethics and the economy. The most recent, published in May, was titled Ethical Choices and Political Challenges.

A British Columbia native, Dr. Clarke has written a number of articles and papers on the ethical implications of contemporary social and public issues in Canada.

The annual lecture is sponsored in memory of two social work students of the Laurier social work faculty who died in a car accident in 1972. The social work faculty joins with the trustees of the memorial fund in presenting the annual lectures.
