Career night to offer advice
for those thinking of school

A community career night, designed to provide information for adults thinking of making a career change or pondering a return to education, will be held Nov. 8 at 7 p.m. in the Paul Martin Centre of Wilfrid Laurier University.

Neil Gibson, the university's mature student career advisor, who has made a career change himself, will discuss career planning and show the Laurier film for mature students, *A Matter of Confidence*.

Information will be available from several Laurier speakers on academic counselling services available at Laurier, how to gain study skills, financial aid available and how those who did not complete high school can still enter university.

Two present students--one a women who returned to studies part-time after her children were older and a man who decided on a career change after many years in one job--will describe their experiences.

The program is offered free to all interested adults. It is sponsored by the part-time studies and career services offices at the university.
