A conference for singles
planned at WLU March 22-23

The Roman Catholic community at Wilfrid Laurier University will hold a conference for single people March 22-23, under the theme Seasons of your Life: There is a season for everything--a time for building...

Kathy Zettel, Catholic chaplain at the university, said the two-day event will examine a number of issues relevant to single people, including their relationships with family members, friends, and the church.

"We will reflect on our experience and situation as singles in the 80s," Zettel said. "We want to say, 'It's okay to be single.'"

A resource person for the conference, which will be limited to 150 participants, will be Rae Struthers, a Cambridge adult educator and psychotherapist.

The session will start Friday at 7:30 p.m. in the Paul Martin Centre at Laurier and end at 6 p.m. the next day, with an informal social time to follow. Singles between 18 and 40 are invited to attend. The cost is \$15, which includes a lunch.
