2 from Toronto join

Laurier's governors

J.E. (John) Cleghorn and Mrs. Eileen Mercier, both of Toronto, have joined the board of governors of Wilfrid Laurier University. They will serve three-year terms, effective May 1.

Cleghorn's father, Edward (Ned), was burser of Waterloo College, the forerunner of WLU, in the 1940s, and instructed in fine arts.

John Cleghorn is executive vice-president, international banking division of the Royal Bank of Canada, and is a nephew of the late Mabel Dunham, Kitchener librarian and author. Mrs. Mercier, nee Falconer, is a senior manager at Gulf Canada Ltd., and is a graduate of Laurier.

John E. Lauer of RR 2, Petersburg, and Philip Rason of Kitchener, both graduates of the university and community members on the board, were re-appointed. New members include Fred McLean, of London, Ont., a 1974 graduate, and Basil Healey, a faculty member.
