University credit courses coming
on Trillium Cable and TVOntario

Wilfrid Laurier University will be offering a number of university credit courses this fall available to Orillia and area residents over TVOntario and Trillium Cable.

Cliff G. Bilyea, acting director of continuing education at Laurier, says the new television courses are an extension of service by the university, which has been offering courses in Simcoe County for more than 20 years.

Courses available on Trillium Cable are courses in criminology and introduction to economics. On TVOntario, there will be courses in anthropology, fine arts, geology, philosophy, psychology, religion and culture, science and sociology.

Fall courses will be offered on television beginning Sept. 10 for 13 weeks. In addition to the TV component, there are supporting texts, books of reading, and audiocassettes in some courses. In addition, there is a teleconferencing session when students and lecturers will be connected by telephone for discussions.

Academic co-ordinator for WLU Telecollege is Carol Brethour, an Orillia native. She is an Ontario Scholar and a graduate of both the Orillia District Collegiate and Wilfrid Laurier University.
