Frank wiley wins 2nd term
as chairman of WLU board

Frank F. Wiley of R.R. #2, Brantford, was re-elected to his second one-year term as Chairman of the board of governors of Wilfrid Laurier University at the board's annual meeting this week.

Wiley, 58, has been a member of the Laurier board since 1982. He attended Waterloo College, the forerunner of Laurier in the 1940s, and graduated in business administration from the University of Western Ontario in 1950. One son is a graduate of Laurier and a second graduates this spring.

A former president of Johnson's Wax (S.C. Johnson and Son Ltd.), he retired in 1983 but remains a member of its board of directors. He had been president of the company for 14 years.

Other officers re-elected were John E. Lauer of R.R. #2, Petersburg, vice-chairman; and Dr. Stephen J. Stack of Waterloo, secretary. It is a second term for Lauer and a third for Stack. Lauer is the vice-president for manufacturing at J.M. Schneider Inc., Kitchener, and Stack is a member of the Laurier faculty.

Eileen Mercier, a Toronto banker first named to the board last year, was elected secretary. Both Mercier and Lauer are graduates of Laurier.
