Laurier to offer 6 courses
at Brampton beginning July 2

Six degree credit courses will be offered in Brampton this summer by Wilfrid Laurier University. Five of the six will be offered in the evenings to suit the convenience of those who work during the day.

Courses offered, from July 2 to August 7 at Brampton Centennial Secondary School on McMurchy Road and at Sheridan College on McLaughlin Road, are geography, communication studies, history, psychology, religion and culture and sociology. The final one is offered during the day.

Students enrolling in Brampton with Laurier can opt to major in these areas: geography, history, psychology, sociology, or religion and culture.

Clifford Bilyea, acting director of part-time studies at Laurier, said there were 31 new students enrolled in spring session classes, just concluding. That's a 55 per cent growth in one year. There were 119 Brampton area students enrolled.

Although normal requirement for admission is completion of Grade 13, students may be able to qualify as mature students if they have two years work experience and are either 21 years of age or over or have Grade 12 standing.
