More than 1,000 graduate
at WLU's largest convocation

More than 1,000 students in graduate and undergraduate programs received their degrees at the spring convocation at Wilfrid Laurier University, the largest in the university's history.

Degrees were conferred in arts, science, business and economics, music, and in social work and a number of other graduate programs. Theology degrees were awarded on behalf of Waterloo Lutheran Seminary, Laurier's federated college.

A feature of convocation was the installation of Maureen Forrester of Toronto as chancellor of the university.

The world-renowned contralto and opera star succeeds the Hon. John B. Aird, former lieutenant-governor of Ontario.

"I wish I were in your shoes," Forrester told the graduates. "There are so many things that I would have liked to have tried and done. You have it all before you."
