WLU to open two new
squash courts Jan. 26

An official opening will be held at 4 p.m., Jan. 26 for the two new squash courts at the athletic building of Wilfrid Laurier University. A reception will follow.

Rich Newbrough, director of athletics, said there will be a ribbon-cutting ceremony, followed by a mini-tournament between two Laurier grads and two current students.

The two new courts are international-size, larger than the four older courts, and will help to alleviate the demand for court time for the popular sport.

Financing for the courts, built at a cost of \$240,000, was provided by the University's Excellence in the Eighties development fund, which has financed many other recent campus improvements. The new courts adjoin the present ones and have a glass wall to facilitate instruction in the game.
