5th annual Texaco Cup  
soccer tourney set for WLU

The fifth annual Texaco Cup indoor soccer tournament will take place this coming weekend, Feb. 5, 6 and 7 at Wilfrid Laurier University.

Last year, the tournament was won for the second time by the host team-- the Wilfrid Laurier Golden Hawks. In a very exciting final, they defeated the University of Toronto 3-2 after twelve minutes of overtime.

Teams participating this year, in addition to the WLU team, are: The Canada (East) Youth team, the University of Waterloo, University of Guelph, Kitchener Selects, University of Western Ontario, University of Windsor, York University, Queen's University, and the University of Toronto.
