Laurier to hold information  
session at Barrie March 8

Wilfrid Laurier University will hold an information night for new and returning part-time students March 8 in the cafetorium of Innisdale Secondary School, Barrie, at 7:30 p.m.

Clifford G. Bilyea, director of part-time studies at Laurier, will discuss the university credit courses that will be offered by the university again this year in Barrie, Collingwood, Midland and Orillia, and on television through WLU Telecollege.

Courses will be offered in music, anthropology, geography, history, psychology, religion and culture, sociology, physical education, plus others, including business, through WLU Telecollege.

Bilyea said that while high school graduation is the ordinary requirement for admission to the university, those with two years work experience and who are either 21 or older, or have completed Grade 12, may qualify for admission.
