Solution for Israel's border conflicts

to be discussed at Laurier March 11

A renowned expert on Israeli geo-political matters will discuss a possible solution to the tensions and conflicts on Israel's borders, in a talk at Wilfrid Laurier University on March 11.

Saul Cohen, a member of the N.Y. governors' school and alliance task force, and a former president of Queen's College

in New York, will speak on the topic, Peace negotiations and Israel's border: a formula for territorial compromise.

The talk will be given at 2:30 p.m. in the main auditorium in the Peter's Building, University Avenue and Albert Street. The talk is sponsored by the Laurier geography department, and is open to the public without charge.

Cohen has written several books on the topic and lectured widely throughout the world on various aspects of the Middle East crisis involving Israel.

Cohen is also the former director of the graduate school of geography at Clark University, in Worcester, Mass., one of the world's top schools of geography.
